TIP #1 The 'TWIST-PULL-TWIST'

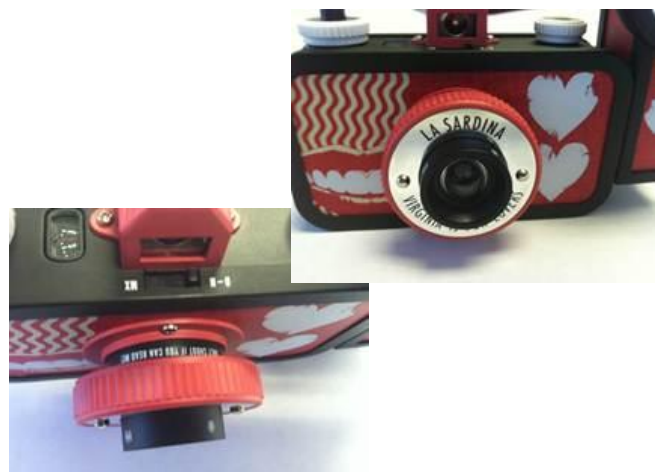
We've had a few questions about the initial use of the camera, including getting the 'Fritz the Blitz' flash included.

(A) First, You'll see that looking at the front of the camera, the words 'LA SARDINA' are top-center in the gold band. Hold the red, plastic ring around that and **TWIST** counter clockwise until it stops.

(B) Second, **PULL** it out until you can read "shoot only if you can read me"



(C) Third, **TWIST** the red, plastic ring **BACK CLOCKWISE** >> Twist back until you hear a **CLICK**. This is very important.

The words "LA SARDINA" will be top-center once again. The camera is ready and the flash connected.

Makes sure with or without the flash, you have the lens pulled out so "shoot only if you can read me" is always visible.
