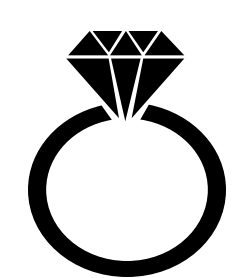


Travel Party Origin by State

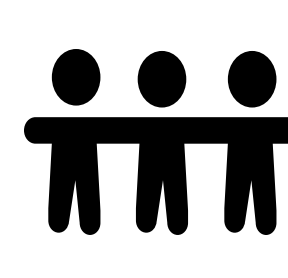

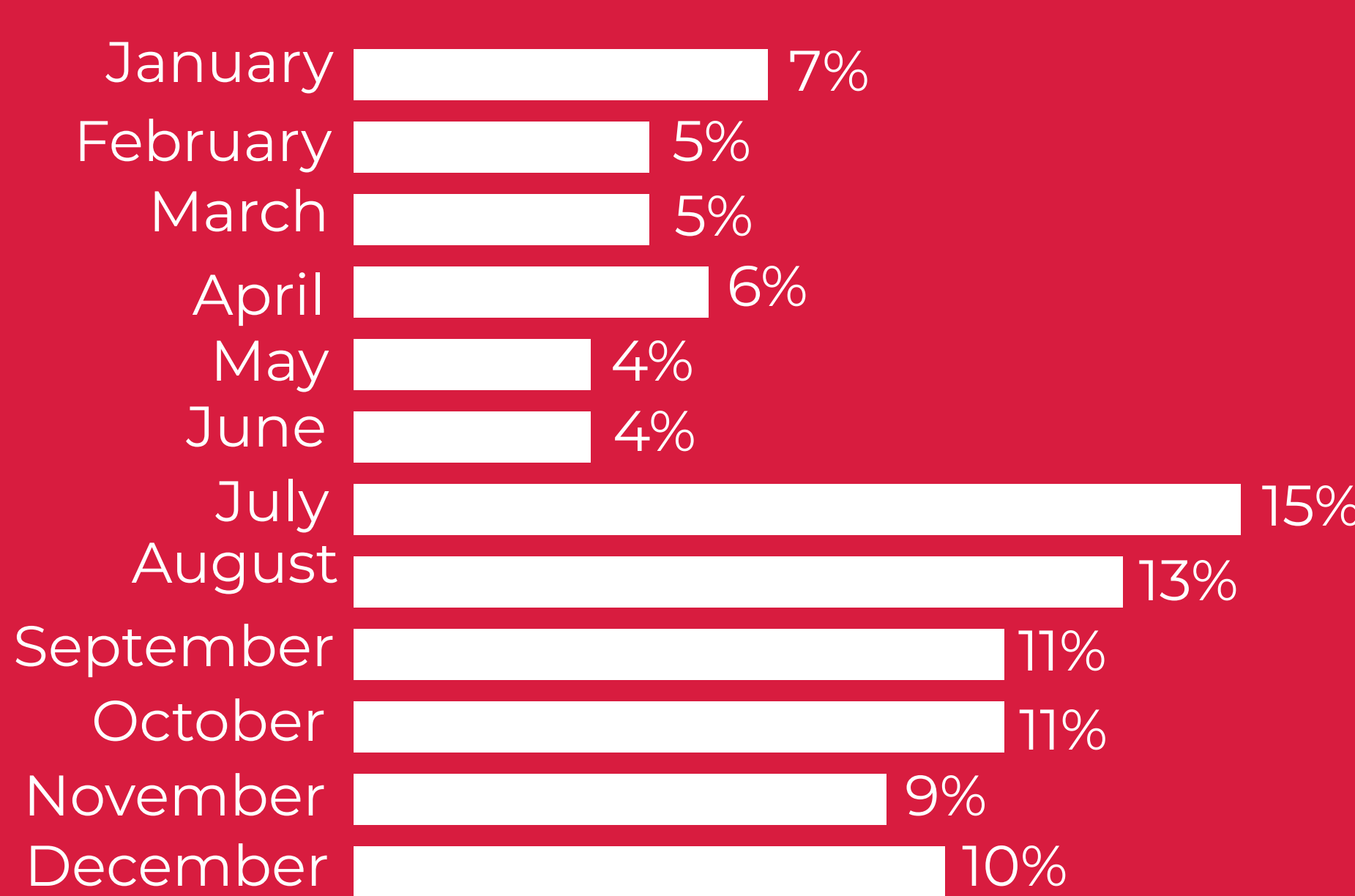

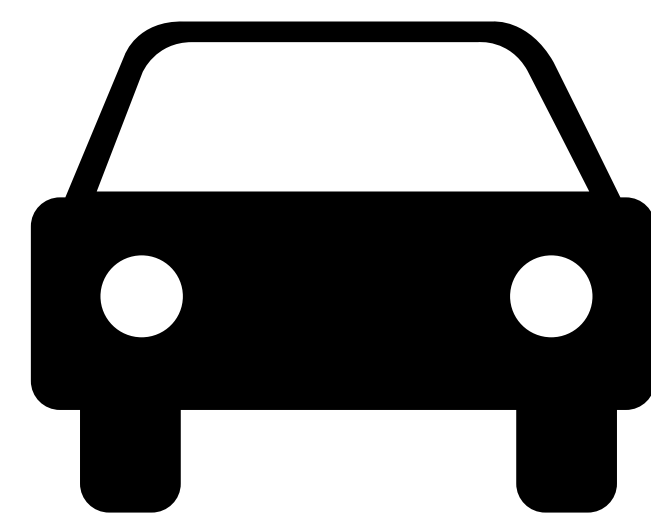
Month of Travel

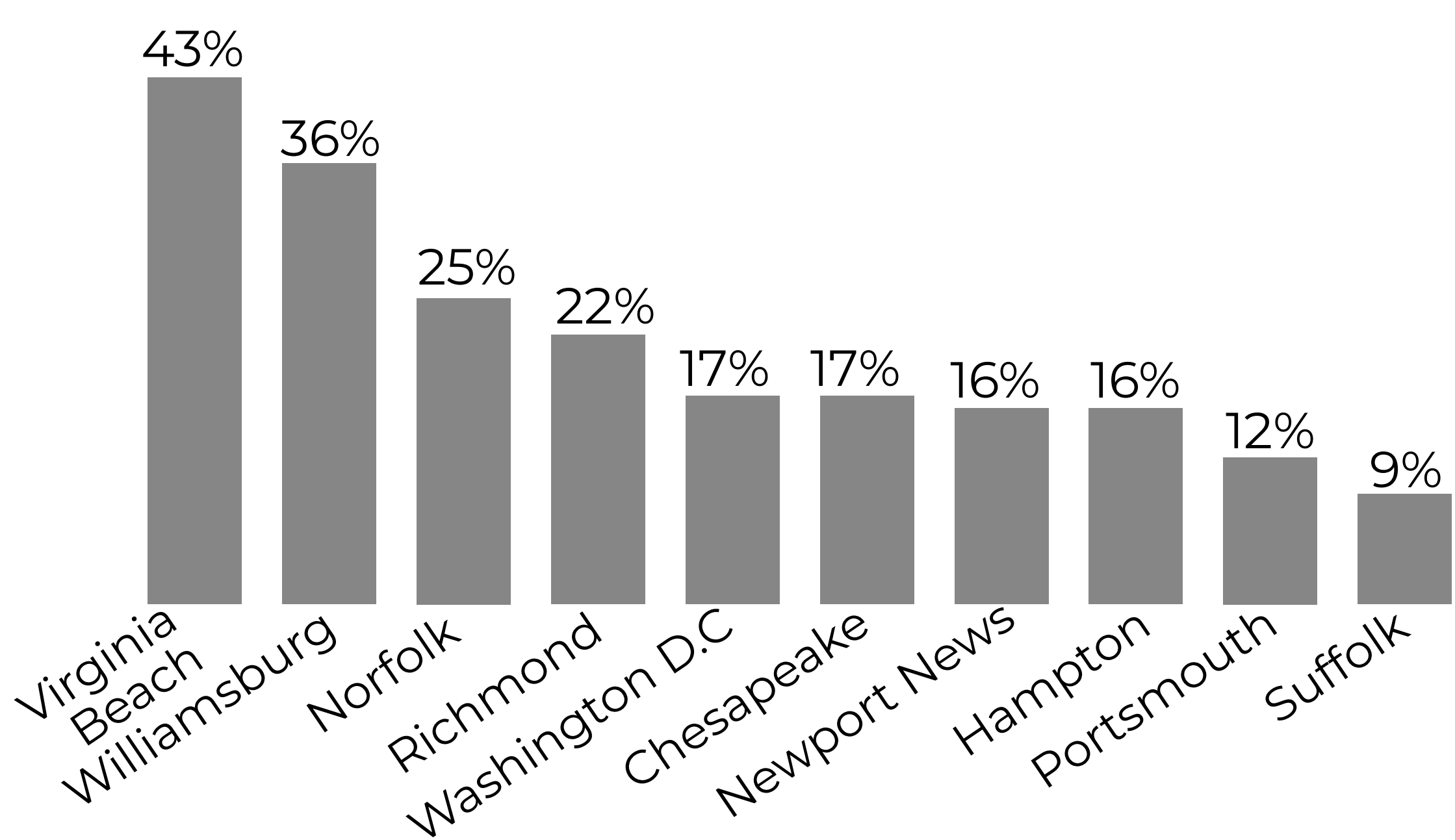
